REPORT AND ORDER  
APPROVING SERVICE AS A MOTOR CARRIER

BY THE COMMISSION:

This matter being before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission upon application of EABORN TRUCK SERVICE, INC., a corporation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, dated May 21, 1976, to operate motor vehicles as a common carrier, and having been duly presented in accordance with the rules of the Commission, and full investigation of the matters and things involved having been had, and it appearing that the rights granted herein are in effect a transfer of the rights which have been held by WILLIAM R. EABORN, trading and doing business as EABORN TRUCK SERVICE, under report and order issued at A. 86527 on July 27, 1959 and the certificate of public convenience issued thereunder, as modified and amended, which certificate will be subsequently cancelled as of the date of this order, upon compliance with the tariff and insurance requirements of the Commission by EABORN TRUCK SERVICE, INC., a corporation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, the Commission finds and determines that approval of the application limited to the following rights:

1. To transport, as a Class B carrier, household goods and office furnishings, in use, between points in the borough of Carnegie and the city of Pittsburgh, Allegheny County, and within five (5) miles by the usually traveled highways of the limits of the said borough.
2. To transport, as a Class D carrier, household goods and office furnishings, in use, from points in the borough of Carnegie and the city of Pittsburgh, Allegheny County, and within five (5) miles by the usually traveled highways of the limits of the said borough to other points within seventy-five (75) miles by the usually traveled highways of the limits of the said borough, and vice versa.
3. To transport, as a Class B carrier, property, excluding store equipment in use, between points in the borough of Carnegie, Allegheny County, and within five (5) miles by the usually traveled highways of the limits of said borough.
